**CEP Workshop  
Exclusion & Criminal Justice  
Cambridge, 1-6 September 1997**

This workshop took place during 1997 which was European Year against Racism. The workshop recognised that racism is the single most important element in terms of exclusion and criminal justice, but also looked at discrimination in its wider forms. Issues of prejudice towards minority groups were addressed, as were emerging trends of nationalism, the treatment of foreign national offenders and working with racially motivated offenders.

The workshop report provides an account of the material presented and makes a series of good practice proposals.
