An Effective Practice Initiative

This workshop, organised for the CEP by the Association of Chief Officers of Probation and HM Inspectorate of Probation, was designed to provide participants with an opportunity to:

- hear about evidence based practice and what research suggests is effective in reducing offending
- understand the What Works strategy for the probation service in England and Wales , including the implications for service organisation and staff training
- consider in particular the process of integrating offenders effectively into the community through the use of employment and training opportunities
- reflect on the implications for their own country and their own organisation.
